Grade School Sectional, District & State Seeding Criteria

The following is an example of how wrestlers will be seeded at the Sectional & District & State. At Sectionals & Districts, criteria will apply to All Wrestlers.

At State, criteria will apply to the District Champions only. Classes: There are 7 classes of seed candidates. Seed Changes will not be made within 72 hours of state.

Computer points to break tie; if tie with computer points the computer randomly selects.

- **Class 1:** Wrestlers that have finished 1-4 at the OAC State tournament the previous season in the same age division entered this year.
- **Class 2:** Wrestlers that have finished 5-8 at the OAC State tournament the previous season in the same age division entered this year.
- **Class 3:** Wrestlers that have finished 1-4 at the OAC state tournament the previous season in a younger age division entered this year.
- **Class 4:** Wrestlers that have finished 5-8 at the OAC state tournament the previous season in a younger age division entered this year.
- **Class 5:** Wrestlers that have finished 1-6 at the OAC district tournament the previous season in the same age division entered this year
- Class 6: Wrestlers not in Classes 1-5 but have computer points
- **Class 7:** Wrestlers without previous year district/state placement and without computer points. They will not be seeded at districts and listed as NS= Not Seeded.
- -All candidates in Class 1 will be seeded higher than those in Class 2 through 7, etc. Wrestlers within a Class shall be seeded on their current computer points.
