



OAC DIVISIONAL STATE TOURNAMENT



Overview

Divisional State is an OAC State Tournament held on February 12th in Central Ohio. The tournament splits the field up by both Age Division and Class (Feeder School Size Large and Small)

How is it Different from OAC Grade School State and OAC Junior High State?

The OAC post-season ends with Grade School State and Junior High State. For these tournaments all athletes of their age group compete in the same class without splitting up based on school size. This single class tournament makes the Grade School and Junior High State a very competitive field. The Divisional State Tournament separates the tournament even further by grouping wrestlers into brackets based on the size of their feeder High School which they are affiliated with. There are 4 Age groups and 2 classes (HS size). The Age groups are based on the year they were born.

How do I enter Divisional State

The OAC Divisional State Tournament is open to anyone using a Parent/Guardian OAC account or a Team Admin/Parent Account. The only qualification requirement is the wrestler has to fit into the age bracket, and have an OAC Account. The brackets are limited to 32 participants per bracket. Registration must be completed 36 hours prior to the start of the tournament.
