



# OAC STATE TOURNAMENTS



## Overview

The OAC State Tournament is an Ohio postseason State Tournament comprised of Grade School, Junior High school, Girls and Freshman divisions. The OAC State Tournaments are hosted at the Covelli Center in Youngstown, Ohio. The OAC State Tournament differs from other OAC Events in a few ways which will be explained in this section.

## When do the different divisions compete?

---

The OAC State Tournaments are hosted on two consecutive weekends with different divisions competing each of the weekends. The first weekend Junior High, Freshman and Girls. The second weekend is the Grade School State Championships.

### Weekend 1

Saturday- Freshman Division and Day 1 Junior High  
Sunday- Girls Division and Day 2 Junior High

### Weekend 2

Saturday - Grade School Day 1 (Division 2, 3 & 4)  
Sunday Grade School Day 2 All Divisions

## OAC State Weigh-in Information

- 1) All OAC State tournament weights have a 2-pound allowance for example if the weight class is 100 pounds the wrestler must weigh 102.0 or below during weigh ins
- 2) DIII, DIV and Junior High participants who make the second day of their tournament will weigh in a second time, The first being on Friday night and the second being Sunday morning. The 2nd weigh in will have a 3-pound allowance.
